MEETING AND COLLABORATION ASSESSMENT REPORT

During the working dinner held on the evening of December 4th with Maryrose Francica, President of the Women Elevation Malta Association, strategic partnership opportunities between the two organizations were evaluated. As a result of the meeting, a mutual consensus was reached to initiate concrete projects starting in 2026.

AREAS OF POTENTIAL COLLABORATION

The projects currently being spearheaded or planned by Maryrose Francica are categorized under the following headings:

- Women's Empowerment: Education-oriented projects involving practical applications.
- Climate and Environment: Partnership opportunities in new-term projects following the completion of the current EU project in June.
- K1 Mobility and VET (Vocational Education and Training): A new project scheduled for drafting in January and submission in March.

IMMEDIATE ACTION PLAN AND TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

The following procedures must be completed urgently to be formally included as a partner in the discussed projects:

- PIC Number Registration: Obtaining the official registration number required to serve as a partner in EU projects.
- Review of Project Draft: Analysis of the draft to be provided by Maryrose in January.
- Institutional Review: Analyzing past projects by reviewing the links provided below.

Note: Obtaining a PIC number is a process that takes only a few hours; however, its completion prior to the January application window is of critical importance.
