REFLECTIONS ON SUSTAIBABILITY

"The Sustainable Legacy of the Republic"

On October 29, 1923, as a nation rose from its ashes, the proclamation of the Republic of Türkiye marked not only the establishment of a new system of governance but also the beginning of a profound social transformation.

The Republic laid the foundations of modernization, equal opportunity in education, enlightenment, and social justice. Today, reading this legacy through the lens of sustainability does more than bridge the past and the future—it demonstrates how both a nation and the world can shape their destinies through reason and knowledge.

"The truest guide in life is science." — Mustafa Kemal Atatürk

Could there be a more timeless expression of the very essence of a sustainable future?

Today, our world faces many challenges—from the climate crisis to energy transition, from income inequality to social justice. Yet, if we look closely, we can see that the early reforms of the Republic were, in essence, the first steps toward sustainable development. Today, showing the same courage in addressing the climate crisis, green energy transition, and social equality is how we honor that legacy.

Because sustainability is, in its essence, the Republic's inherent desire for progress— The Republic itself is sustainability.

Atatürk's words — "My mortal body will surely turn to dust one day, but the Republic of Turkey will live forever." — embody the soul of this sustainable legacy.

Uluslararası Sürdürülebilir Kalkınmada Kadın Derneği (USKD) kuruluşunun 1'inci yılı kutlaması

kapsamında Tekno-Fütürist & Seri Girişimci, İş İnsanı Alphan Manas'ı ağırladı. Alsancak Küçük Kulüp'te düzenlenen etkinlikte konuşan Alphan Manas, Geleceğe Ne Kadar Hazırız? Başlıklı sunumuyla geleceğe dair geniş bir projeksiyon çizdi. USKD Yönetim Kurulu Başkanı



Ayla Alkan, sürdürülebilir bir gelecek ve üretim için 1 yıldır önemli projeler geliştirdiklerini söyledi. İzmirli iş kadınları olarak, diğer kurumlar ve STK'larla işbirlikleri geliştirdiklerini belirtti; kadın haklarının yanısıra eğitim ve istihdama yönelik çalışmalara ağırlık verdiklerini vurguladı. Alphan Manas da, "Tarım sektörünün önemi çok artacak. Su tasarrufu için bitki temelli et ve dikey tarım öne çıkacak. 2018'de yapılan bir araştırmaya göre Türkiye gıda sürdürülebilirlik endeksinde 67 ülke arasında 58'inci sırada yer alıyor. Tarım alanında mutlaka modern uygulamaların yaygınlaşması gerekiyor" ifadelerini kullandı.
